Notes:

- murder of a child:
- serious sex offence, including carnal knowledge;
- child-related personal violence offence (an offence committed by an adult involving intentionally wounding or causing grievous bodily harm to a child);
- indecency offences punishable by imprisonment of 12 months or more;
- kidnapping (unless the offender is or has been the child's parent or carer);
- · offences connected with child prostitution;
- possession, distribution or publication of child pornography; or
- attempt, conspiracy or incitement to commit the above offences.

^{II} A prohibited person is someone who is a registrable person as defined in the <u>Child</u> <u>Protection (Offenders Registration) Act 2000</u> or has been convicted of one of the following offences:

The National Register is a register established by a canon of the National Church containing details of complaints of sexual misconduct or child abuse made against clergy and lay people which have been made to, or dealt with by, a church body.

^{iv} **Mental incapacity**' means a person who has a **mental incapacity** within the meaning of the *Mental Health Act* 2007 (NSW) or *Mental Health (Care and Treatment) Act* 2004 (ACT) or a person who is a managed person within the meaning of Chapter 4 of the *NSW Trustee and Guardianship Act* 2009 (NSW) or a person for whom a guardian has been appointed because the person has an impaired decision-making ability within the meaning of the *Guardianship and Management of Property Act* 1991 (ACT);
