Two exciting ministry opportunities exist in our Diocesan Chaplaincy team.

The Goulburn Correctional Centre (GCC) is a male supermaximum prison in Goulburn NSW. It is operated by Correctional Services NSW, an agency of the Department of Justice. The Anglican Diocese of Canberra + Goulburn is contracted to provide a full-time Chaplain who works collegially alongside other Chaplains (full and part-time) from other denominations and other faiths to provide Chaplaincy Services within the prison.

Junee Correctional Centre (JCC) is a mixed-security prison for men in Junee NSW. It is operated privately by the GEO Group Australia in accordance with regulations prescribed by the NSW Department of Justice and NSW State Legislation. The Anglican Diocese of Canberra + Goulburn is contracted to provide a full-time Chaplain who works collegially alongside other Chaplains (full and part-time) from other denominations and other faiths to provide Chaplaincy Services within the prison.

The successful candidates need to juggle the different spheres of accountability. They will be directly accountable to the Archdeacon for Chaplaincy and Mission; accountable onsite to the Governor of the GCC/JCC; and accountable to the Chaplaincy Coordinator, Chaplaincy Services under the oversight of the Civil Chaplaincies Advisory Committee (CCAC).

The successful candidates will have:

- A deep, personal commitment to our Lord Jesus Christ;
- Excellent pastoral care skills and experience;
- A solid understanding of the theology and practice of the Anglican Church, particularly as it is expressed with the Diocese of Canberra + Goulburn;
- The ability to work collegially within a multi-disciplinary, multi-denominational and multi-faith environment;
- Bachelor Qualifications in Theology, including pastoral Care or equivalent;
- A current Driver's Licence;
- Fully Compliant with all Safe Ministry Requirements.

It is desirable that the successful candidates:

- Will be an Ordained Priest within the Anglican Church of Australia;
- Have experience/training in drug and alcohol addiction; mental health

Applicants will be required to undertake the psychometric profiling instrument and must obtain a Working With Children clearance through the Office of the Children's Guardian (NSW) and undergo a National Criminal History Check prior to an offer of employment.
