

Jesus is the Good Shepherd

This week in our series in Acts, we look at Paul speaking to the Ephesian elders as he left and warning them of wolves in sheeps' clothing. This concept is a little hard for younger people, so kids church will be looking at a similar concept of being sheep and Jesus being our Good Shepherd.

Bible Story: Jesus is the good shepherd

Big Idea: We are the sheep, and Jesus is our Good shepherd

Big Verses: 'I am the good shepherd; I know my sheep and my sheep know me.' John 10:14

Activity: Make a sheep with a shepherd guarding it. This is like us and Jesus, he looks out for us.

Idea 1 - Using cotton wool balls, make a flock of sheep

Idea 2 - Using a paper plate as the body, make the legs and head of the sheep

Idea 3 - Use a cotton pad as the body and make a sheep

Extra Activity: Make a wolf that is covered in sheep's wool. Can you disguise the wolf so it looks like a sheep? A colouring sheet is also available:
