ST SAVIOUR'S NATIONAL AND REGIONAL IMPORTANCE

Mother Church of the Anglican Diocese of Canberra and Goulburn and a large part of southern and eastern NSW, St Saviour's Cathedral has been a proud Goulburn landmark since its consecration in 1884.

The diocese was proclaimed in 1863 by Letters Patent from Queen Victoria, thus making the original smaller brick St Saviour's Church (circa 1839) a Cathedral and Goulburn Australia's first inland city.

Soon after, in times of great prosperity from the wool trade, it was popularly decided that Goulburn should have a wonderful golden sandstone Cathedral befitting the area's importance. The renowned Colonial Architect Edmund Blacket was commissioned to design what is now regarded as his – and Australia's – finest example of decorated Gothic Revival church architecture.

Nowadays, except during recent pandemic restrictions, thousands of people from around Australia and across the world visit in reverential awe to experience the special beauty and spiritual warmth of this unique place of worship.

St Saviour's is open every day and performs many local and wider diocesan functions: parish church; setting for large events such as installation of bishops and ordination of other clergy; weddings, baptisms and funerals; concerts and music recitals.

St Saviour's Cathedral is listed on the NSW State Heritage Register, the Register of the National Trust of Australia and the Register of the National Estate.
