

Facilitation Instructions

This is a 1 hour, face-to-face, locally facilitated course, aimed at providing your “teen helpers” (aged 12-17 years) with a basic induction into the core concepts of Safe Ministry.

It includes downloadable videos, a facilitator’s guide, participants handouts, parent/guardian permission form and a certificate template.



As the local facilitator, prior to the session:

a. Familiarise yourself with the resources

- Click on the link you receive via email.

b. Download the resources

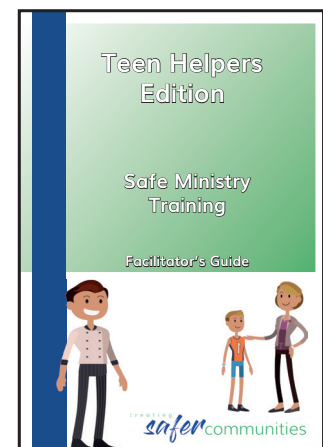
- Download the videos and printable resources to your computer.
- Print the guide, handouts and permission form.

c. Run a facilitators' session

Hold a preparation session where you run through the material with other leaders that will co-facilitate the training session with you.

d. Gain parental permission

Use the downloadable form to gain permission from the *Teen Helpers' parents/guardians*.



Remember this is a shared learning experience, when you run your session be sure you and your co-facilitators provide a supportive and safe space for your Teen Helpers to explore the concepts together.
