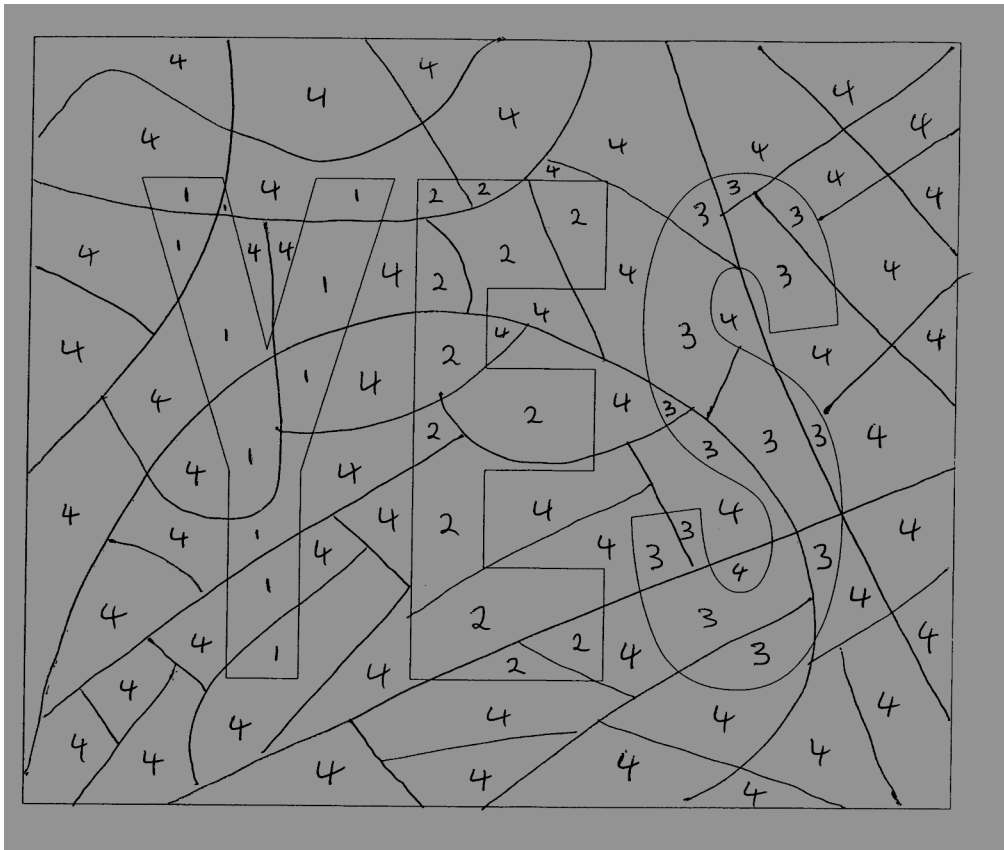
He grew up and died on a cross and rose again.

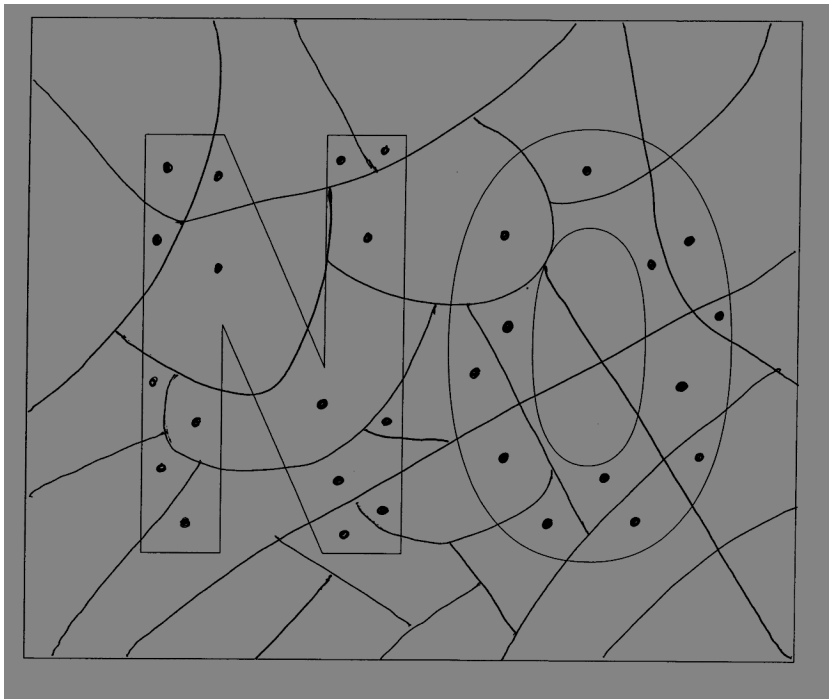

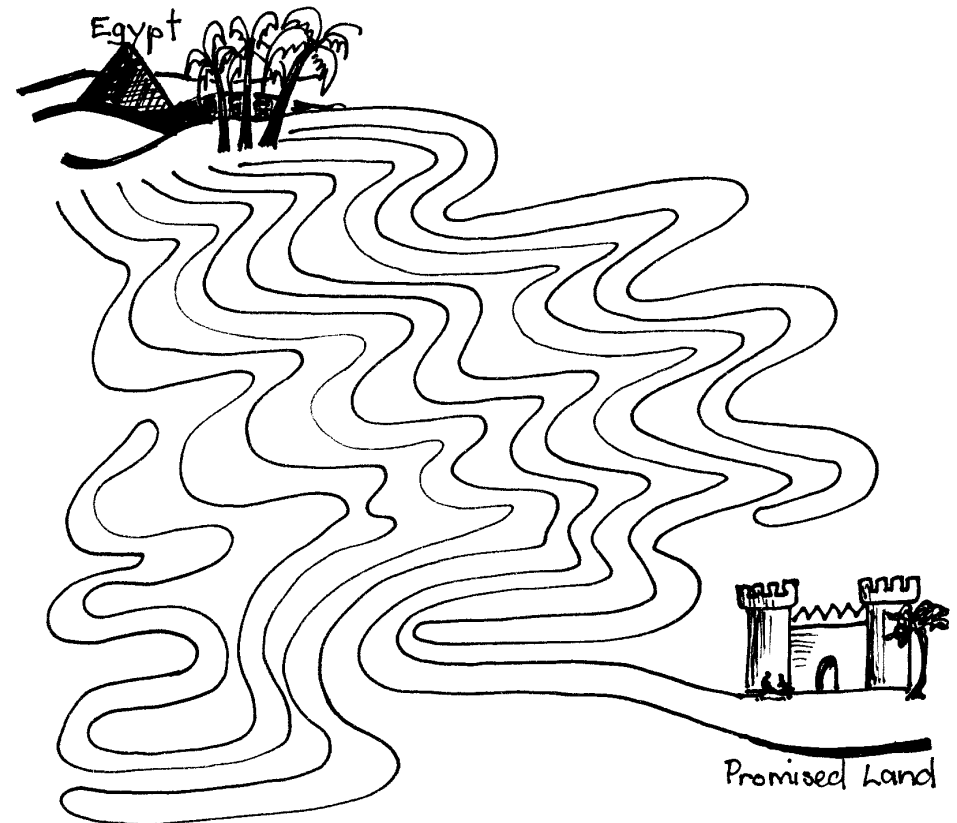
