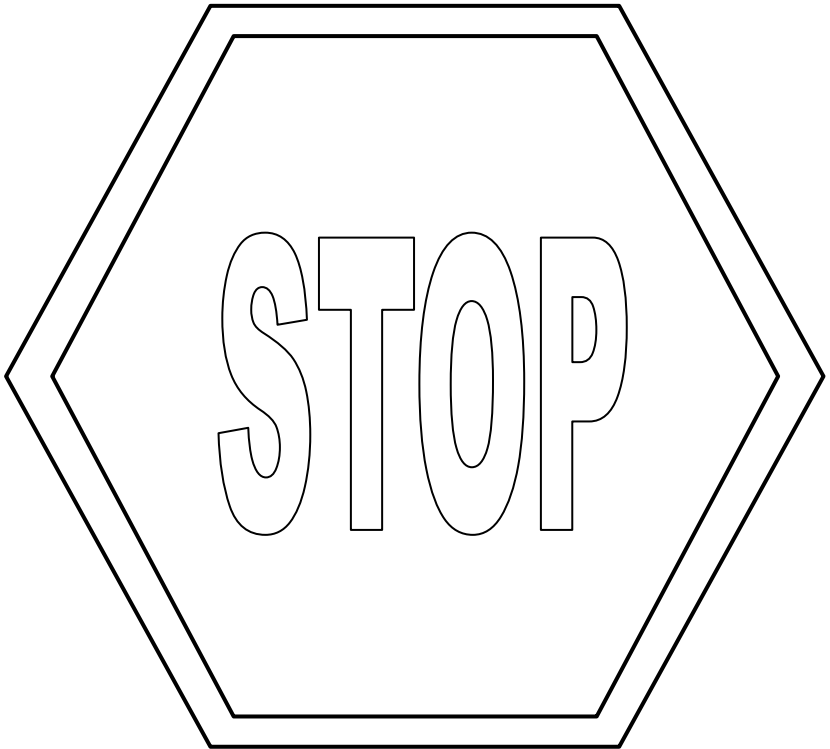

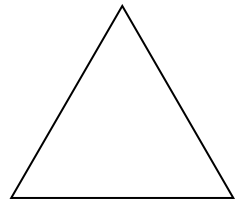
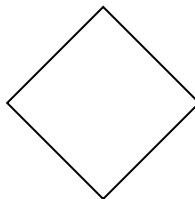
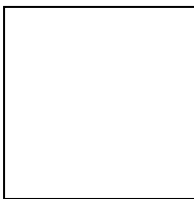
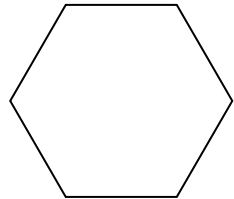
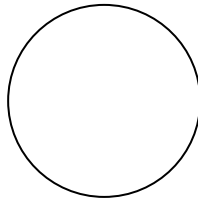
When we become a Christian
